Additional Information for this Tour:

Visa:

All Swiss or American Citizens are required to have a Visa to enter Russia. The Cost for the Visa itself is CHF 140.—and requires a Visa Invitation, Filled out Application with photo, proof of payment and your passport submitted to the Russian Embassy **IN PERSON** more than 3 weeks prior to departure with a self addressed, return envelope with registered mail already stamped.

For those who wish to complete this on their own, Fritsche Reisen will supply the Visa Invitation free of charge. For those who wish us to complete this procedure for them there is a Visa Fee of CHF 50.— per passport and visa delivery fee of CHF 50 per delivery (ie. A couple submits two passports, there is a total fee of CHF 150) which includes the registered postage fee of CHF 10.- .

Optional Tours:

Friday, April 2nd – **Yusupov Palace** - made history in 1916 when Prince Felix Yusupov, with his associates, murdered the infamous Rasputin, advisor to Czar Nicholas I. Today the scene is recreated with wax figures. This grand palace was converted in the 19th Century to a Classical style as evidenced by the 6 pillars at the main entrance. Worth seeing are the splendourous art treasures, as well as the Russian baroque theatre, contained within where today regularly scheduled concerts take place.

Saturday, April 3rd – **Pushkin: The Summer Palace of Catherine I** - We drive outside the city today to the village of Pushkin, so named after the father of Russian poetry and modern Russian literature! Here we visit the famous summer palace of the Russian Czar, Catherine I, „Zarskoi Selo“ and it's famous Amber Room!
